Report on the return

We have audited the accompanying Registered Party Financial Transactions Return (the "Return"), Statement of Financial Position and Statement of Revenue, Expenses and Surplus of the Libertarian Party of Canada for the year ended December 31, 2019. This return has been prepared by the Chief Agent of the Libertarian Party of Canada based on the financial reporting provisions of Section 432 (1) of the Canada Elections Act and in the prescribed form issued by Elections Canada.

The Chief Agent's responsibility for the Return

The Chief Agent is responsible for the preparation of the Return in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Section 432(1) of the Canada Elections Act and in the prescribed form issued by Elections Canada and for such internal control as the Chief Agent determines necessary to enable the preparation of a Return is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the Return based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the Return is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the Return. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the Return, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the Return in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control.
