Section F – Privacy notice

Personal information in the *Candidate's Statement of Unpaid Claims and Loans 18 or 36 Months after Election Day* (Statement) is collected for the administration of the political financing requirements as set out in the *Canada Elections Act* (Act). This information may be shared with the Commissioner of Canada Elections to ensure that the Act is complied with and enforced. Failure to provide the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) with the Statement is considered to be an offence under the Act. The Act requires the CEO to publish the Statement in the manner that he or she considers appropriate. Upon request by any person, the CEO is required under the Act to make the Statement available for inspection by such person. You have the following rights with respect to your personal information under the *Privacy Act*: a) to access the information; b) to correct it if necessary; and c) to have it protected. You have the right to file a complaint with the Privacy Commissioner of Canada regarding the handling of your personal information.
