



When to use this form

This form is used to apply to register an electoral district association of a registered party with Elections Canada. Registration allows an association to perform certain regulated transactions, such as issuing tax receipts for contributions.

This form consists of the following parts:

- Part 1 Association's information and leader's declaration
- Part 2 Chief executive officer's and association officers' information
- Part 3 Financial agent's information
- Part 4 Auditor's information

Important reminders

- If you are using a standard PDF reader, the information entered in the form cannot be saved. Be sure to print all completed pages before closing the document.
- Make sure the completed form is signed by hand and dated.
- Incomplete or illegible information will delay the processing of your submission.

Tips for completing the form

Parts 1 to 4

Complete all parts of the application. All fields are mandatory, unless otherwise indicated.

Parts 2 and 3

The same person cannot be both the financial agent and chief executive officer of a registered association because both are required to act, either jointly or alternately, under the *Canada Elections Act*.

- · Corporation incorporated under the laws of Canada or a province
- Not eligible to be a financial agent:
- · Candidate*
- · Election officer or member of the staff of a returning officer
- · Undischarged bankrupt
- Auditor appointed as required by the Canada Elections Act
- · Person who does not have the full capacity to enter into contracts in the province or territory in which the person ordinarily resides
- · Person who is a member of a partnership that has been appointed as an auditor for a political entity other than a registered party

*A candidate, nomination contestant or leadership contestant continues to be a candidate or contestant after the election or contest period, until they have fulfilled their reporting obligations (for example, after they have paid their claims and loans, disposed of their surplus funds and closed the bank account).

Section B – Auditor's declaration

Eligible to be an auditor:

- Person who is a member in good standing with a provincial or territorial governing body of chartered professional accountants (CPA designation)*
- Partnership of which every partner is a member in good standing with a provincial or territorial governing body of chartered professional accountants (CPA designation)*

Not eligible to be an auditor:

- Candidate** or official agent
- · Election officer or member of the staff of a returning officer
- · Chief agent of a registered party or an eligible party
- Registered agent of a registered party
- · Financial agent or electoral district agent of a registered association
- Leadership contestant**, their financial agent or a leadership campaign agent
- Nomination contestant** or their financial agent
- · Financial agent of a registered third party

*Provincially or territorially legislated accounting bodies may require auditors to meet other professional criteria in order to perform this role, such as holding a public accounting licence in the province or territory where the political entity is based.

**A candidate, nomination contestant or leadership contestant continues to be a candidate or contestant after the election or contest period, until they have fulfilled their reporting obligations (for example, after they have paid their claims and loans, disposed of their surplus funds and closed the bank account).
