

NOTICE OF A REGULATED FUNDRAISING EVENT

A registered party's chief agent must notify the Chief Electoral Officer of a regulated fundraising event no later than five days before the day the event takes place.

Exception: No notice is required for regulated fundraising events held during a general election period.

Section E – Privacy notice

<p>Personal information in this <i>Notice of a Regulated Fundraising Event</i> (Notice) is collected for the purpose of notifying the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) of a regulated fundraising event as set out in the <i>Canada Elections Act</i> (Act). This information may be shared with the Commissioner of Canada Elections to ensure that the Act is complied with and enforced. Failure to provide the CEO with a notice of a regulated fundraising event is considered to be an offence under the Act. Upon request by any person, the CEO is required under the Act to make the Notice available for inspection by such person. You have the following rights with respect to your personal information under the <i>Privacy Act</i>: a) to access the information; b) to correct it, if necessary; and c) to have it protected. You have the right to file a complaint with the Privacy Commissioner of Canada regarding the handling of your personal information. Your personal information is retained under the personal information bank (PIB) Political Financing Elections PPU 010. A description of the PIB can be found at elections.ca.</p>
